The Salisbury Beach Betterment Association (SBBA) is pleased to offer scholarships for 2018 in accordance with the following regulations. These regulations were established in April 1991 by the original Scholarship Committee, revised in April 2009 and 2010, and govern the awarding of the scholarships.

Criteria

The applicant must be a child or grandchild of an SBBA member. The member must be of good standing in the SBBA for a minimum of three consecutive calendar years prior to the scholarship request.

The applicant must be a 2018 high school/secondary school graduate with a GPA of at least 2.75.

Scholarships will be given for attendance at eligible institutions of higher learning, which shall include full term of study in any accredited two or four-year college or university as well as any accredited schools of vocational training.

Application Procedure

The application and all other related materials must be mailed “Certified With Return *Receipt Requested*” to the above address and postmarked no later than May 1, 2018. Hand deliveries will not be accepted. Applications received after this deadline will not be eligible for funding.

All applications must be completed and submitted with the following:

1. Certified copy of the applicant’s high school transcript including at least two consecutive senior year terms of grades and indicating a GPA of at least 2.75
2. Letter of reference from a high school faculty member
3. Essay of at least 300 words: Interview a parent or grandparent about their most significant or fondest memory of Salisbury Beach. Describe this memory in your essay.
